1. Identify the scale type for part a: major, natural minor, harmonic minor, or melodic minor.
2. Convert the scale of part a to the scale type listed for part b
3. Circle the notes in part b that changed from a to b.
4. Draw an up or down arrow to indicate the direction of the change from a to b.
5. Draw the scale note number of the changed note next to the arrow.
